

Principles of handling municipal waste in the area of the Intercommunal Union "Waste Management Center - SELEKT"



Put the paper in **blue bag** and put it in front of the property

Throw in!

Paper packaging, cardboard, catalogs, leaflets, brochures, newspapers and magazines, school and office paper, printed cards, notebooks, books, notebooks, wrapping paper, paper bags and sacks, paper rolls (e.g. on toilet paper).

Don't throw in!

Greasy, dirty and wet paper, hygienic paper (toilet paper, handkerchiefs, towels, cotton buds, nappies), varnished and waxed paper and coated with foil, milk and beverage cartons (so-called multi-material packaging), paper bags for fertilizers, cement and other construction materials, wallpapers, greasy disposable packaging from paper and disposable tableware.



We throw metals and plastics into **yellow bag** and put it in front of the property.

Throw in!

Plastics - empty and crushed: plastic beverage bottles, plastic packaging for food products, packaging for household chemicals (e.g. cleaning products, washing powders and liquids, etc.), packaging for cosmetics (e.g. shampoos), plastic bags, bags, plastic bags and other foils, caps / caps.

Metals - empty and crushed: aluminum and steel cans for drinks, juices and canned food, caps, jar lids.

Multi-material packaging - empty and squashed: milk and juice cartons.

Don't throw in!

Packaging with contents, used electronic equipment, batteries, accumulators, packaging for paints, varnishes, engine oils and other hazardous substances, plastic toys, car parts.



Put the glass in green bag and put it in front of the property.

Throw in!

Bottles, jars of beverages and food, glass packaging for cosmetics (if they are not made of several materials permanently connected).

Throw in waste without contents.

Don't throw in!

Ceramics, flower pots, porcelain, faience, crystals, glass, glasses, heat-resistant glass, candles, light bulbs, fluorescent lamps, reflectors, solvent and oil packaging, mirrors, window and armored glass, monitors, TV lamps, thermometers and syringes.

Don't throw in broken glass.



We throw in BIO waste in bulk (not in packs), to a brown container and put it in front of the property.

Throw in!

Kitchen waste: plant origin - fruit and vegetable residues, incl. peelings, apple core, fruit and vegetable preserves (e.g. corn, peas, canned fruit), mushrooms and mushroom peels, nuts, apple mousse, dried fruit, fruit and vegetable preserves (e.g. jams),

toothpicks, paper coffee filters, egg shells, coffee and tea grounds

Green waste: plant residues - leaves, grass, weeds, small twigs (not thicker than a school pencil), cut flowers, wilted, potted flowers, also the root system without soil, nut shells, needles, cones.

Don't throw in!

Bones and fishbones, bread and other bakery products (e.g. casseroles, sandwiches), cooking oil, animal excrements, meat, eggs, earth, ash, stones, remnants of salad, candied fruit, cooked potatoes, French fries, rice, pasta, groats, yeast, wood ash.



Everything that we cannot selectively collect we throw into **container for mixed** / residual waste.

Don't throw in!

Hazardous waste, e.g. paints, varnishes, solvents, expired medicines, used electrical and electronic equipment and other hazardous substances.

Do not throw in hot ash and construction debris.



Expired medications

Each resident has the option to return expired medicines and medicine packages to pharmacies free of charge.
